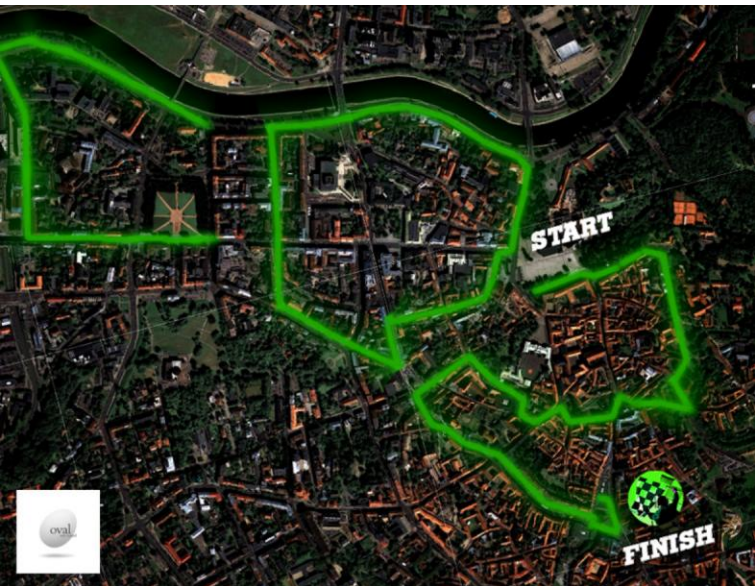

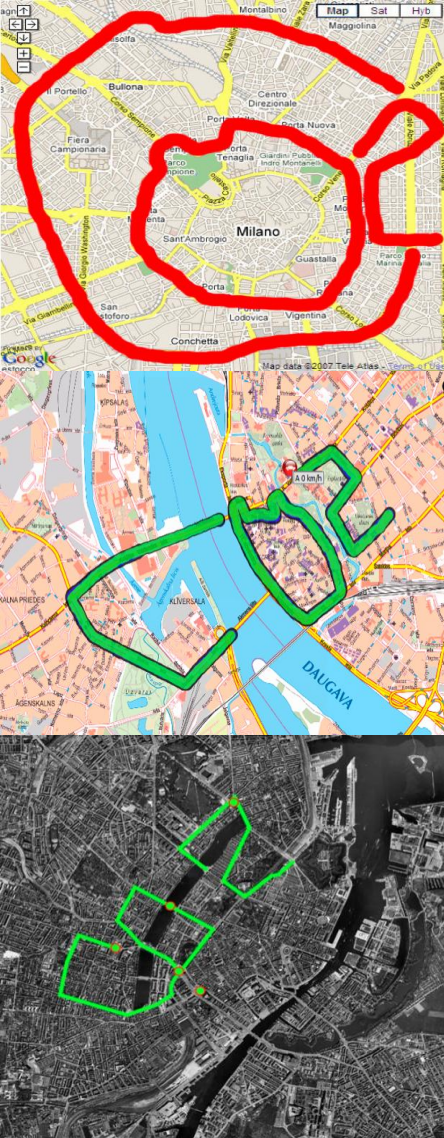

What is “Vilnius CO2 Green Drive”?

- Vilnius CO2 Green Drive is an international interactive art and climate event intended to create awareness and motivate the general public to take an active part in addressing climate issues and the related challenges of urban transportation. This intention is achieved by “tagging” cities across the world with a massive CO2 sign virtually “painted” by a public parade of environmentally friendly vehicles equipped with color coded GPS tracking devices driving a route in the shape of a “CO2”.
- Vilnius CO2 Green Drive is accompanied by a photo and video competition. By taking pictures of the parade, along the route and during the events, uploading the pictures and “GeoTagging” them on Google maps as a part of the competition, an everlasting “CO2” sign will virtually appear above Vilnius on Google Earth. This not only motivates citizens of Vilnius to take an active part in the event by documenting memorable moments, but becomes a constant reminder of our obligations to create a greener on healthier environment.
- As part of Vilnius CO2 Green Drive several projects have been developed directly targeted at children and families. One of the concepts is called “Pimp my Hope” and involves the building of the electric car HOPE from 1982 in recycled cardboard, both in 1:1 and in mini versions.
- Official representative, celebrities, sponsors and investors from Vilnius and Lithuania are invited to commence Vilnius CO2 Green Drive and drive the vehicles during the parade.
- Vilnius CO2 Green Drive will finish with a conference discussing the current situation in Lithuania.

Imagine: the most powerful environmentally friendly vehicles in the very heart of Vilnius

What happens on October 23, 2010 during Vilnius CO2 Green Drive?

Vilnius CO2 Green Drive starts with an exhibition of environmentally friendly vehicles on Vilnius Town Hall Square and is open for all environmentally friendly vehicles. After the exhibition all vehicles will drive a CO2 route through Vilnius that will be screened live on the internet where the CO2 painting will appear on an aerial photo of Vilnius. The painting will also be screened live during the event on outdoor monitors. The parade will again finish on Vilnius Town Hall Square where all participating cars will be presented in form of a fashion show on a long Catwalk, decorated with sponsor and investors' logos.

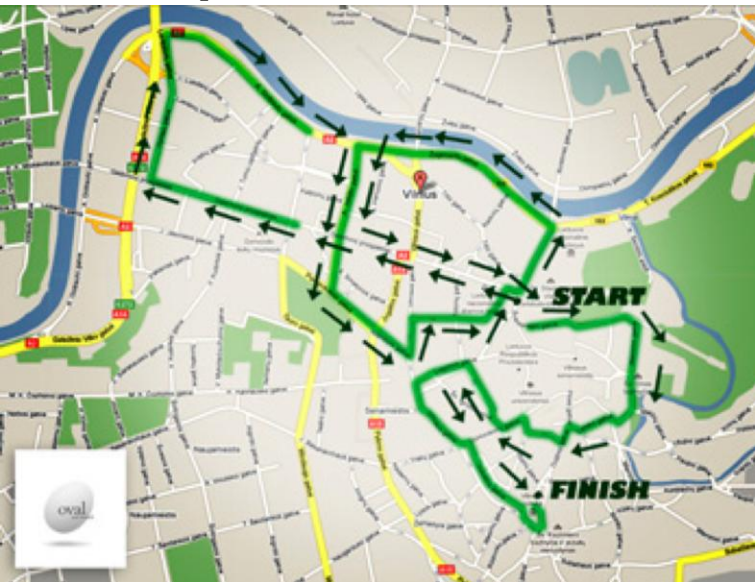
From the central stage a Conférencier and DJ will be hosting the event and guiding these activities:

- Drag Race between fast fuel cars and most powerful electric vehicles.
- Screening of the award winning documentary “Who Killed the Electric Car?” together with the famous American film director, Chris Paine.
- The Eco-Drive Academy: who will drive more economical and environmentally friendly.
- The Eco-Rally: Up to 40 cars with sponsor logos aiming for not the fastest but most economical and environmentally friendly result.
- Kids painting the cardboard car “Hope” and writing their wishes for the future.
- Green Design: Presenting fashionable environmentally friendly designs, clothes and gadgets.
- The Eco Laboratory: Teaching how to create new things from recycled once.
- The Eco Market: selling bio and ecological food and clothes.
- The Eco Restaurant: Selling ‘healthy green food’ and giving ideas on healthy recipes.
- The performance of Radio Controlled Cars.
- Showing how 100 KG of CO2 looks like.
- Closing party for special guests and an auction of the original CO2 painting of Vilnius.

Awareness Raising and Publicity for the event:

- Webpage & Social Network Group for Vilnius CO2 Green Drive 2010: Webpage and Social Network Group will serve as our information and PR platform. The webpage will contain: partners and sponsors with links / list of participants / press releases / program / news / CO2 painting / promo videos / the photo competition / private interviews
- TV & Viral Program: “Convert my Car”: A simple fuel powered car will be selected and converted in 8 weeks into electric car. The car will be decorated by Lithuanian artists (Possibly with Sponsor Logos) and drive in the Vilnius CO2 Green Drive parade.
- 30 seconds Teaser / Commercial: A viral video triggering the public and raising awareness about Vilnius CO2 Green Drive. This teaser can contain logos of main contributors and can be showed on TV and internet.
- Promotional slides and videos, presenting our main contributors, will be screened on the 4m X 6m LED screen during the event.
- 2-3 minutes Promo video about Vilnius CO2 Green Drive: A viral video informing and inviting to the public about Vilnius CO2 Green Drive and additional events.
- 7-10 minutes Documentary, documenting Vilnius CO2 Green Drive: Will be documenting and promoting our event in and outside Lithuania during other CO2 Green Drive events (Denmark, Milan, New York, LA, Sao Paulo, Beijing etc.). This video will contain logos of contributors and will pay special attention to main sponsors within the documentary, for instance, in form of interviews with them or their representatives.
- Posters and flyers: Will contain logos of contributors and will be spread in Vilnius.
- LED screen on Vilnius Town Hall Square: During the event the TV Program, promos, teasers, the official webpage, the CO2 painting will be screened. There is a possibility for our contributors to be presented on the screen during the event.
